

MINUTES of the ANNUAL PARISH MEETING of Hough on the Hill, Brandon and Gelston held on Thursday 15th March 2018 at 7 pm at All Saints Church, Hough on the Hill.

1. Apologies Cllr Rhymer and Cty Cllr Maughan.
2. The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held in 2017 were read and approved and it was unanimously agreed, that they be signed.

7. Diane Hansen, Head of Engagement and Inclusion at South West Lincolnshire Clinical Commissioning Group gave a presentation of their 5 year plan for Sustainability and Transformation (2016 – 2021). Their aim is to try and keep things local and to use hospitals as a last resort – there is a huge shortfall in the number of staff required, in all areas. Various ideas are being considered such as triage at hospitals in an endeavour to avoid admissions into hospital. Some people don't understand the system and seem to clog up A & E departments rather than see a GP or dial 111. There are a number of different IT systems which do not talk to each other and they are piloting a system to get over this issue. A suggestion was made that perhaps apprenticeships for nurses would be a better option than graduates as nurses; also that partners of RAF personnel were, historically, quite often nurses and perhaps this could be investigated through the RAF.
